NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT on Tuesday, November 2, 2010 a General Election will be held in the MAYERS MEMORIAL HOSPITAL District, which includes voters in Shasta, Lassen and Modoc Counties.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN THAT at the General Election to be held in the MAYERS MEMORIAL HOSPITAL District, there will be submitted to the voters the following bond measure and it shall be entitled "Measure D."

LOCAL QUALITY HEALTHCARE AND SEISMIC SAFETY MEASURE. To improve local healthcare and the hospital, seismically upgrade acute care and emergency facilities to maintain local emergency care, expand diagnostic and laboratory capabilities, enhance technology, maintain local critical care, and purchase mortgaged assets to reduce operating costs, shall Mayers Memorial Hospital District be authorized to issue up to \$14,000,000 in bonds at legal interest rates, with a Citizens' Oversight Committee, annual audits, and with NO funds used for administrator salaries?

Because Mayers Memorial Hospital District extends over three counties, verified arguments for and against this measure may be submitted to the County Clerk in any of the three affected counties' offices for publication in that county's official election information. The Shasta County Clerk's office at 1643 Market Street, Redding, CA 96001 in the Market Street Promenade; the Lassen County Clerk's office located in the Courthouse at 220 So. Lassen St., Suite 5, Susanville, CA 96130 or the Modoc County Clerk's office located in the basement of the Courthouse at 204 S. Court Street, Alturas, CA 96101. In all cases, arguments for or against the measure must be submitted not later than August 16, 2010 which has been determined by the County Clerk(s) under the authority of Section 9502 of California Elections Code to be a reasonable date based on the time reasonably necessary to prepare and submit the arguments. No argument shall exceed 300 words in length. Arguments may be submitted by the governing board of the district or a member or members authorized by it, any individual voter, any bona fide association of citizens or a combination of such voters and association of citizens.

Pursuant to Section 9503 of the California Elections Code, one argument for and one argument against each measure will be selected for printing and distributing to the voters in the voter pamphlet in each county. Preference and priority in selections will be given to arguments as follows:

1. The governing board of the MAYERS MEMORIAL HOSPITAL District or member or members of the board authorized by the board;
2. Bona fide associations of citizens;
3. Individual voters who are eligible to vote on the measure.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that at the General Election of November 2, 2010, the polls will be open from 7:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN THAT at the General Election of November 2, 2010 there will be a central counting place for each county involved for the tabulation of ballots cast at

said election. For Shasta County, said central counting place will be the Shasta County Elections Department at 1643 Market Street, Redding, CA 96001 in the Market Street Promenade. For Lassen County, said central counting place will be the County Clerk's office located in the Courthouse at 220 So. Lassen St., Suite 5, Susanville, CA. 96130. For Modoc County, said central counting place will be the County Clerk's office as well located in the basement of the Courthouse at 204 S. Court Street, Alturas, CA 96101.
